- No loose or hanging materials permitted.
- Each poster must depict the theme.
- A one paragraph statement describing how the poster reflects the theme is required to be affixed to the front of the poster.
- The back of the Poster shall have the student’s name, telephone and address, age, grade level, parents’ names, as well as the school, teacher’s name, class and address (\*see form below)
- Entry deadline is April 25, 2008.
- Winners will be announced May 1, 2008.
